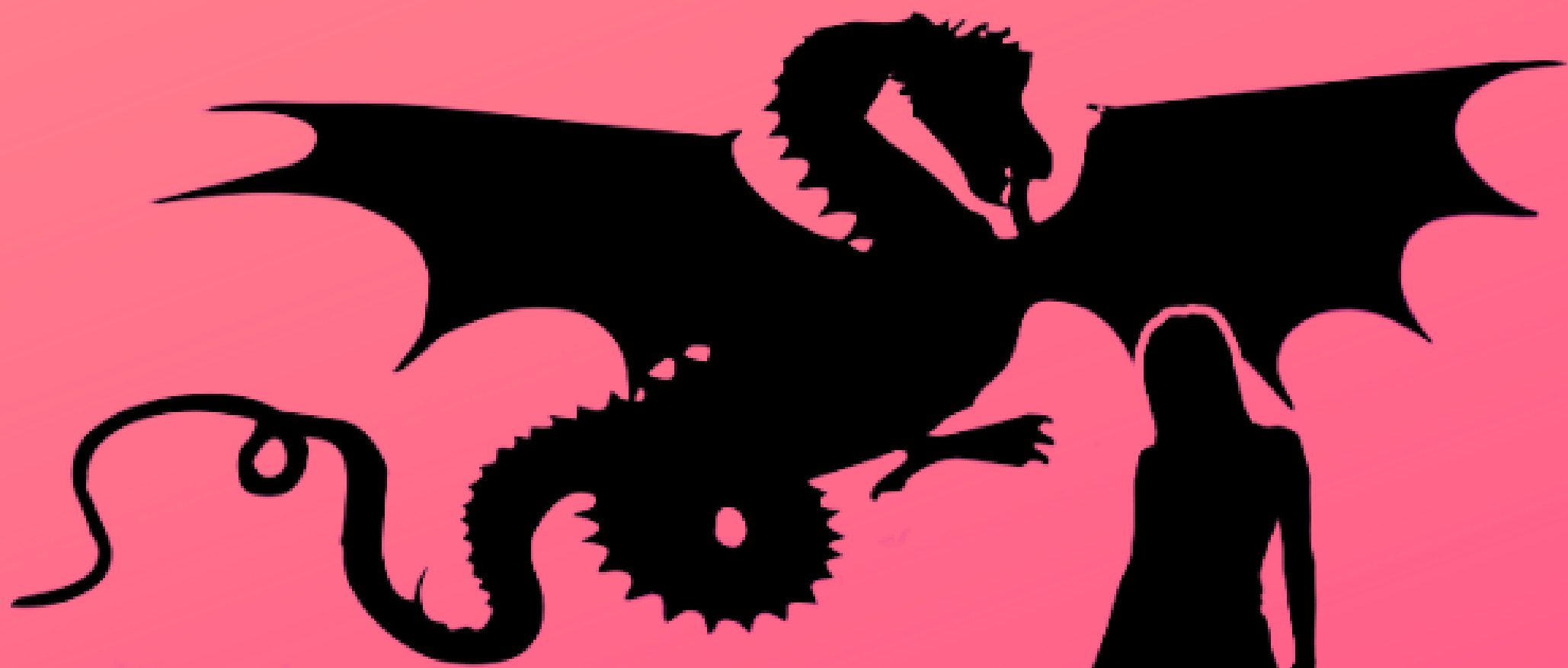

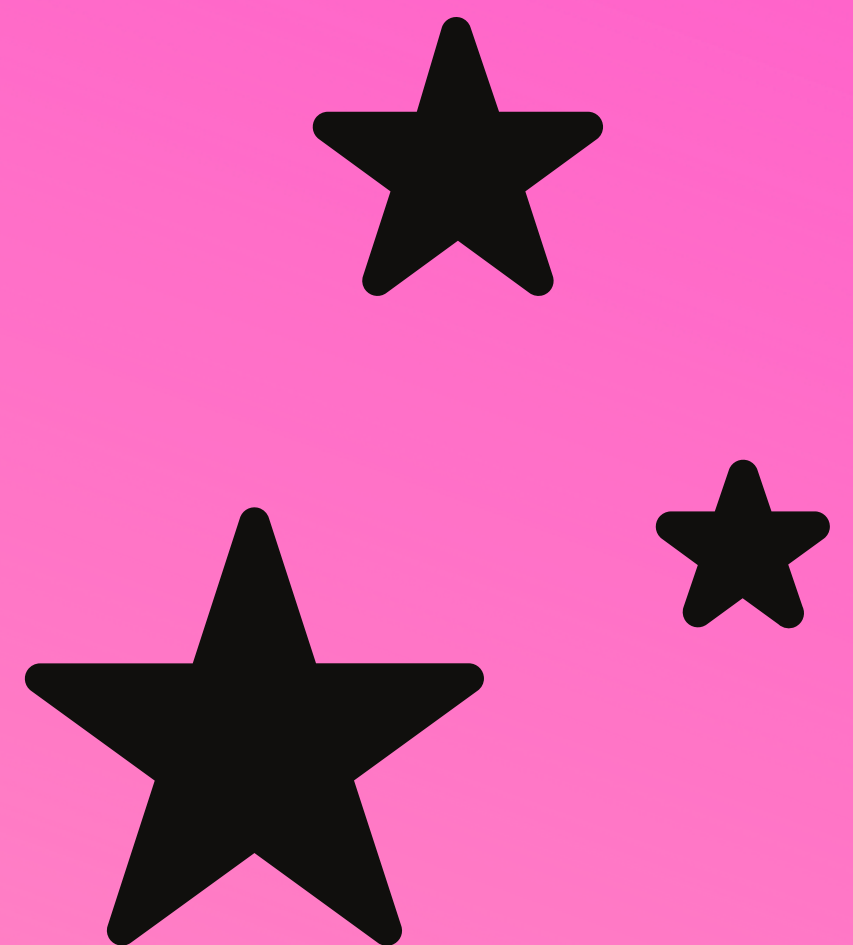

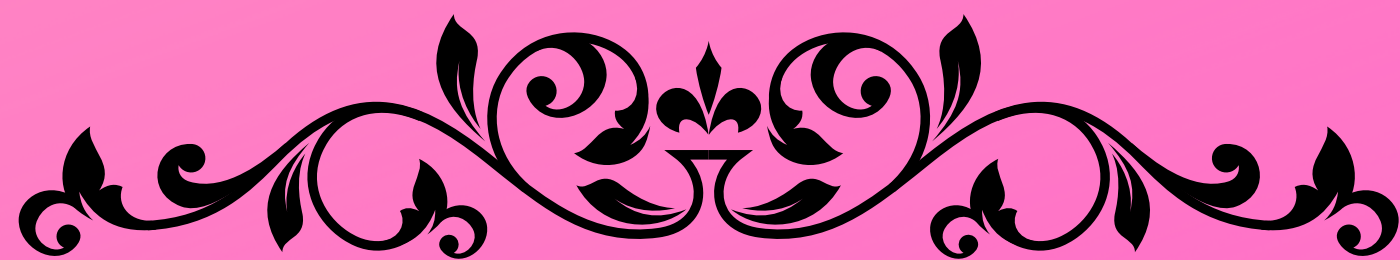
No photography or video recording during any part of the show.

Last seen on the stage six years ago in University Theatre's production of Eurydice, Susie is happy to be killing monsters once again.

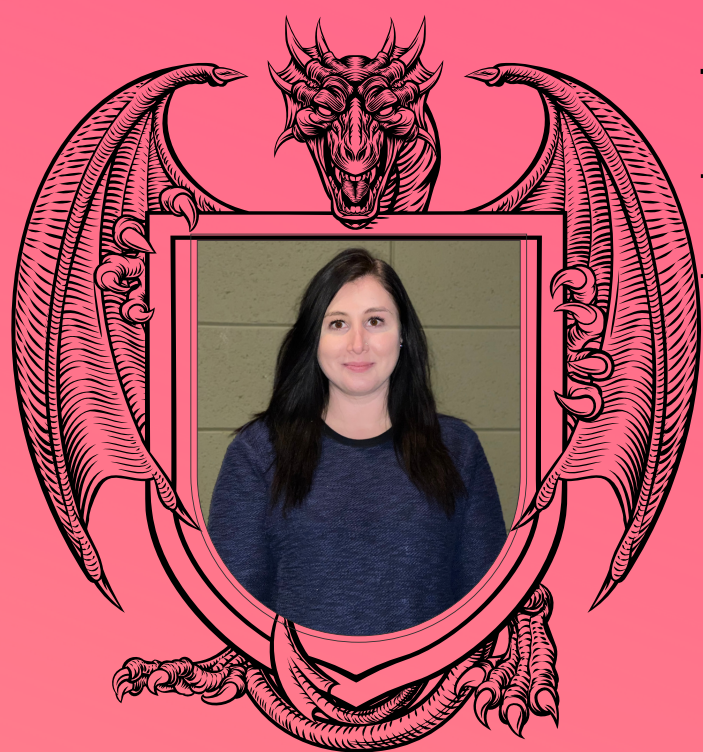

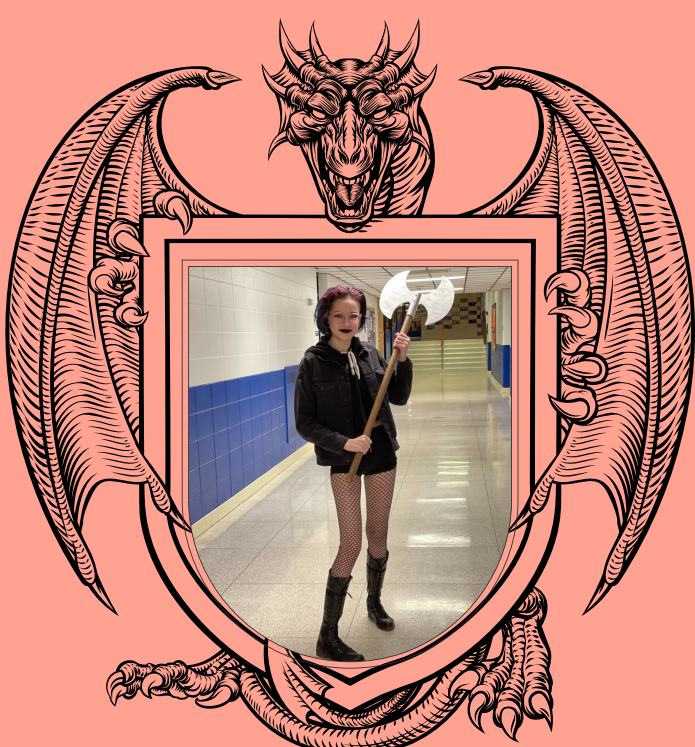
Corrine is a first level DnDer and a 13th level actor who is grateful to be back on stage.

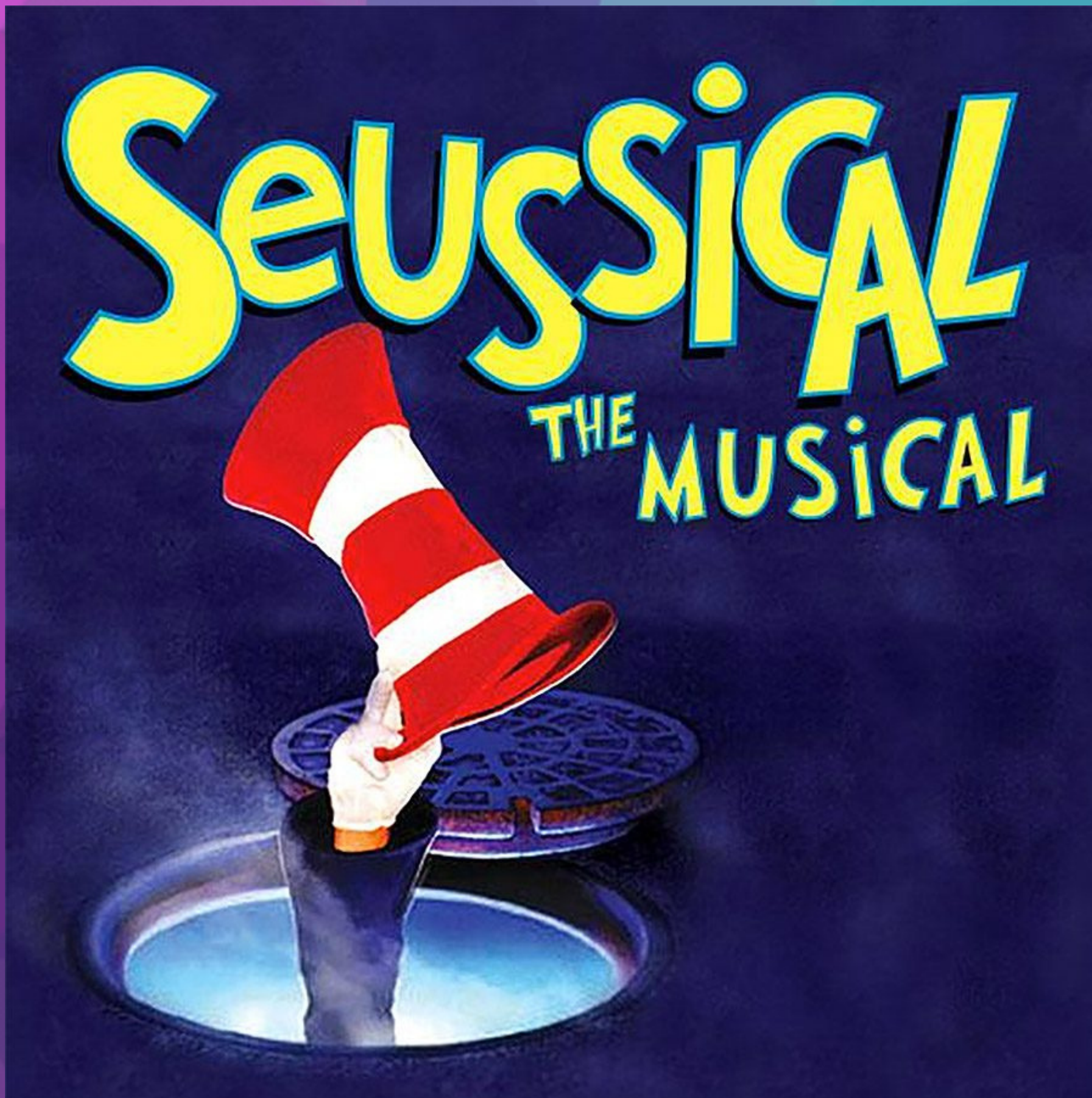
